EVENTS IN THE LIFE OF ANGE TENEDINE

I. World Affairs:

Day of Birth, March 17, 1907

Teddy Roosevelt met with his friend, Governor Dereen of Illinois, seeking support for his Secretary of State, William Howard Taft, to replace him as President.

Day of Marriage, September 25, 1937

Mussolini announces that Italy and Germany were pursuing a common policy, after arriving in Munich to meet with Hitler for talks.

Day of Death, June 9, 2000

The U. S. House of Representatives passed a bill to repeal the Federal Estate Tax.

II. Science:

Day of Birth, March 17, 1907

The Touring Board of the AAA announced the exact route for the Glidden Cup Tour, for motor car competition.

Day of Marriage, September 25, 1937

80 Japanese airplanes bombed Nanking for seven hours, causing 200 deaths and heavy damage.

Day of Death, June 9, 2000

MP3.Com, an internet company, agreed to pay two record companies, Bertelsman and Time-Warner, \$20 million in damages for unauthorized on line music distribution, thus settling a law suit.

III. Feast Days:

Day of Birth, March 17, 1907

St. Patrick, who, after being sold into slavery, returned to Ireland to convert it to Christianity.

Day of Marriage, September 25, 1937

St. Sergius, a mystic and hermit in Russia, who in one of his visions saw the Blessed Virgin.

Day of Death, June 9, 2000

St. Ephrem, who founded a theological school in Edessa, where he preached and wrote books to confute the errors of his time.
